### **New Record Set for Natural Gas Consumption on January 16**

The combination of extreme temperatures and high industrial and power plant natural gas consumption this past weekend, have resulted in a new daily record for natural gas consumed in Saskatchewan. TransGas has set a 24-hour record on January 16, delivering 1.29 PetaJoules of natural gas to its customers. This is two per cent greater than the previous all-time Saskatchewan load peak day that occurred on January 4, 2015.

A PetaJoule is equal to a million GigaJoules (or units) of natural gas. The average home in Saskatchewan consumes about 105 GigaJoules of natural gas annually.
