NON-BINDING OPEN SEASON FOR FUTURE DATED NIT TO TEP TRANSPORT SERVICE
OPEN SEASON CLOSSES JANUARY 10, 2019

TransGas Limited (TransGas) hereby announces a Non-Binding Open Season for Future Dated Nova Inventory Transfer (NIT) to TransGas Energy Pool (TEP) Transport Service. This Non-Binding Open Season is being conducted pursuant to the terms and conditions contained within [the TransGas Comprehensive Tariff](#) and the terms and conditions set out herein.

Based on the results of the Non-Binding Open Season, TransGas will submit a formal request to NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL) to increase the NGTL capacity required in order to offer TransGas customers incremental NIT to TEP transport service. NGTL may need to expand their facilities in order to accommodate the requested incremental transport, and will require TransGas to respond to a Binding Open Season for this transport at a later date.

TransGas will issue a Binding Open Season for future dated NIT to TEP service once NGTL has issued their Binding Open Season for additional capacity. TransGas' Binding Open Season will match the conditions as outlined by NGTL; it is expected that the earliest effective start date will be November 1, 2023. NGTL typically awards Open Seasons for incremental Firm capacity based on contract length, as such, customers will be required to submit competitive term lengths. In NGTL's previous Open Seasons, contract terms have been highly competitive; awarded bids averaged over twenty years in duration.

NIT to TEP service is a stacked toll comprised of the applicable [TransGas receipt toll \(R11.0\)](#) plus an [Additional Cost Recovery \(ACR\)](#) charge. TransGas rates are available on the TransGas website and subject to change. In their request for service, customers will indicate their desired minimum and maximum volume and requested in-service dates. Staggered contract start dates can be requested, TransGas will evaluate prior to issuing the Binding Open Season if the staggered dates can be accommodated. The renewal rights, shed deadlines and other terms associated with this service will be identified in the Binding Open Season to correspond with the terms associated with NGTL's Binding Open Season.
