

TransGas Breaks Another All-Time Natural Gas Usage Record For Transport to Provincial Load

Daily natural gas consumption in the province has set a new record of 1.50 PetaJoules (PJ) on December 29. This record was set in the 24-hour period between 9 a.m. December 29 and 9 a.m. December 30.

For seven consecutive days from December 25 to December 31, the provincial load was at or in excess of 1.40 PJ. All of these days surpass the 1.33 PJ record from the 2016/17 winter.

The new natural gas consumption record is due to the extreme cold temperatures, along with high natural gas consumption from industrial customers and power plants. The 1.50 PJ record is 13 per cent higher than the record set last winter.
