

**1. Definitions**

The terms used herein shall have the same meanings as are ascribed to in the corresponding terms in the Definitions section of the Tariff, unless otherwise defined herein.

**2. Description of Service**

Subject to the Terms and Conditions herein, this Service Specification provides the Customer a Point-to-Point Transportation Service with the ability to transport Gas from a Point of Receipt in the Hatton Tolling Zone of Saskatchewan for delivery to the interconnecting pipeline of:

- TransCanada PipeLines Limited at the Points of Delivery of either Success or Bayhurst,
- Foothills Pipelines (Sask.) Ltd. at the Points of Delivery of Piapot/Crane Lake

for subsequent delivery out of Saskatchewan. The Service may be Diverted by the Customer on a Daily basis to the alternate Point of Delivery, TEP. This Hatton Transportation Service is available on a Firm basis.

For Hatton Transportation Service (Undiverted), Customer may hold Energy imbalances within Shipper's Imbalance Account, within tolerance prescribed by TransGas and as outlined in the General Terms and Conditions.

**3. Service Availability**

Hatton Transportation Service is available to Receipt Points located within the Hatton Tolling Zone of Saskatchewan. The Hatton Tolling Zone is depicted on Figure 1 of this Service Specification. The Hatton Tolling Zone is:

- North of Township 8,
- South of the South Saskatchewan River,
- East of the Alberta/Saskatchewan border, and
- West of Range 22 W 3M

in the Province of Saskatchewan.

The maximum contracted Hatton Transportation Service will be 200 TJ/day of Service.

Hatton Transportation Service is available to Customers subject to the Customer executing a TransGas Service Agreement and a Schedule of Service, and returning same to TransGas.

**4. Nomination Procedures**

All Customers receiving Hatton Transportation Service are required to comply with the Nomination Procedures, applicable to this Service, set out for Customers in the Tariff.

**5. Hatton Diversion Service**

Customers holding Hatton Transportation Service may Divert their deliveries under this Service from the contracted interconnecting pipeline Point of Delivery to TEP on a Firm basis. Customers must Nominate for Diversion in compliance with the Nomination Procedures set out in the Tariff.

**6. Term of Service**

The term of the Hatton Transportation Service shall commence as of the Effective Date being November 01 of any calendar year on or after 2001, for durations of three (3), five (5), ten (10), or fifteen (15) years. The Shipper shall have the right to request an additional three (3), five (5), ten (10) or fifteen (15) year term up to the level of the original Contract Demand.

Hatton Transportation Service will not Evergreen at the end of their term. The Customer is required to provide TransGas with a new request for Service at least six (6) months prior to the expiry of the current term, in accordance with the Tariff.

**7. Transfers of Service**

Transfers of Hatton Transportation Service must be to another eligible Points of Receipt or Delivery for this Service. Point of Receipt transfers are only permitted, subject to the other transfer criterion contained in the Tariff, to other Points of Receipt within the Hatton Tolling Zone. Points of Delivery transfers are only permitted, subject to the other transfer criterion contained in the Tariff to the other interconnecting pipeline eligible for this Service.

**8. Application for Service**

Applications for Hatton Transportation Service under this Service Specification shall be in a form as TransGas may prescribe from time to time. Such applications must be received by TransGas at least six (6) months prior to the requested Effective Date.

**9. Service Rates**

The Service Rates for the Hatton Transportation Service, as well as, for Diversions under this Service, are found in the Rates and Charges section of this Tariff.

**10. General Terms and Conditions**

The General Terms and Conditions of the Tariff and the provisions of the TransGas Service Agreement for Hatton Transportation Service are applicable to this Service Specification to the extent that such Terms and Conditions and provisions are not inconsistent with this Service Specification. In the event there is a conflict between the provisions referenced herein and the terms and conditions of the Schedule of Service, TransGas and Customer agree that the provisions of the Schedule of Service shall prevail.
